Arrived on scene about 245pm. Kansas Turnpike mile marker 114, Southbound lane. Front end of semi trailer had caught fire. Front right side of trailer was burned and product had fallen on to roadside. Spoke to Jason and Jake with FlintHills Towing. Ten totes of corn grits already loaded on two flat bed trucks. They left and took totes to a warehouse at 700 Overlander St., Emporia. When they returned, they loaded 5 totes on another flat bed. I followed this flat bed truck back to the warehouse on Overlander and embargoed 15 totes of corn grits. I returned to the scene. Remaining totes were on trailer, spill from ground was cleaned up and placed in trailer.
